Created in 2010, the Grands Prix Cyclistes de Québec et de Montréal are the only UCI WorldTour races held in the Americas. Every year, the world's best professional cycling teams and riders compete in two of the most demanding and prestigious one-day races on the international cycling calendar.

On September 11 and 13, 2026, the events will celebrate their 15th edition, taking place less than ten days before the 2026 UCI Road World Championships. With redesigned race courses, the Grands Prix Cyclistes de Québec et de Montréal will serve as a key dress rehearsal ahead of the biggest cycling event of the 2026 season.
